
PBIS (POSITIVE BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS AND SUPPORTS)

- is based on principles of applied behavior analysis and the prevention approach and values of positive behavior support.
- a prevention-oriented way for school personnel to (a) organize evidence-based practices, (b) improve their implementation of those practices, and (c) maximize academic and social behavior outcomes for students.
- PBIS supports the success of ALL students.

BUS NORMS

- All students are provided bus transportation to and from school each day
- Rules are to be honored. Violations and consequences are located in the CCPS Code of Student Conduct.

CAFETERIA

- Using a lunch account is the most efficient method of ensuring that students have money for lunch.
- Eliminates the chance of money being lost or stolen
- “My School Bucks” enables you to check your child’s account balances, monitor purchases, add money to your child’s lunch account, etc. Visit www.myschoolbucks.com to register your student account or send cash or a check payable to “Windy Hill Middle School” with your child’s first and last name, and his/her student ID# written in the comment area. The student then gives it to the cafeteria staff during the lunch shift
- There is a \$10 minimum for all checks and a \$25 processing fee on all returned checks
- Prices may change for the 2017-2018 school year
- Currently, breakfast \$1.65 (reduced breakfast \$.30); lunch \$2.80 (reduced lunch, \$.40)
- We also offer an A La Carte lunch menu, which includes items such as pizza, sandwiches, salads, and more. These items are individually priced.
- Students needing breakfast go directly to the cafeteria upon arrival in the morning
- Students may visit locker, if needed, after breakfast
- Students are in 1st period by 8:15a.m.
- Students have four minutes to visit their lockers before lunch, and must report straight to lunch.
- Students sit at assigned tables based on the next class they will attend.
- As a matter of safety, backpacks placed under tables while students are eating
- Students who do not abide by cafeteria rules, will receive cafeteria referrals

CELL PHONES

- Students may bring electronic and communication devices, including cellular phones, laptops, tablets, etc. to school.
- These are high risk items for theft, loss, and/or damage
- Calvert County Public Schools and Windy Hill Middle School will not be responsible for the theft, loss, and/or damage of electronic and communication devices.
- Students must adhere to the individual classroom procedures
- Devices used in a manner disruptive or distracting to the school environment may be confiscated, require parent pick-up, restricted from school property, and/or lead to consequences
- Devices should be registered by completing the Electronic and Communication Device Registration form
- The camera function of any device must not be used on school property unless used for instructional and/or academic purposes, with the approval of administration and/or a teacher.
- Students may use electronic communication devices on school property up to 15 minutes prior to the first bell.
